New Zealand tertiary institution during 2010

OR:
who completed the final year of their course in 2009.

TIMING: The award closes 4.30pm on Wednesday 18 August 2009.
Late entries will not be accepted.

ENTRIES: You are invited to submit entries presenting a work/project completed in the 2009 or 2010 academic year. The award is offered to encourage creativity and excellence in contemporary New Zealand craft and design. The award aims to celebrate creative solutions and artistic merit. The entry should exhibit innovative and imaginative ideas in any of the various media related to the fields of craft or design. The finished craft or design product should have the potential to be displayed at TheNewDowse; or be able to have a recording made of it for display (if it is selected). The entry should exhibit an excellent standard of presentation.

FORMAT: A maximum of four A3 firm backed panels to be mounted with the following:

1. The brief you were given by the tertiary institution, or were asked to generate yourself under the auspices of the institution.
2. A written statement from you clearly identifying the essential elements of your response/solution to the brief; including the ideas and thinking behind your solution and the process of creating it (up to 500 words).
3. High quality photographs and/or drawings/images to visually communicate your project. CDs/DVDs or other material which cannot be viewed solely on the panels are not acceptable and will not form part of the judging.

JUDGING: The panel of judges will include: one member of TheNewDowse team, one NewDowse Friends committee member and one other person who is actively involved in the arts/design sector. The judges will consider the degree of creativity, ideas driving the solution to the brief, artistic merit and the quality of presentation in their assessment and reserve the right not to make an award if an acceptable standard is not reached. Successful applicants will be advised by 9 September 2010.
